

STRIKE AND VIOLENCE AT NHAVA SHEVA PORT

Dear customers,

this is to inform you that the GTI workers have gone on strike on Saturday late evening onwards, which affected the overall movement of all the containers stuffed on January 17th, 2015.

There was a huge pendency and back log of containers which resulted in long queues of vehicles affecting the movement of all the three terminals.

The situation became more serious on Sunday when there were clashes between police and trailer operators. One of the police van was put on fire by the mob and the situation went beyond control at that time. Additional police force was deployed at Nhava Sheva late evening on Sunday to control the situation.

Our agent managed to gate in some of the containers before this Dramatic situation started.

Since January 18th afternoon the roads heading towards all the three terminals were blocked and no containers could be gated in.

We will keep you all informed.
